Advantage of affiliation: -

- 1. President and Secretary of the society will have representation in a managing committee which will have meetings 2 times a year in which inputs will be taken from all for UPSOS activities at the local level.
- 2. All information regarding activities of UPSOS will be sent to the individual societies too by UPSOS so that information is disseminated to all.
- 3. Any achievements of members could be shared with UPSOS to be published in the annual report.
- 4. Discounted prices for affiliating society for membership of UPSOS will be floated from time to time as offers.

- 5. Affiliated societies can propose programs under the UPSOS banner after approval from the UPSOS Executive committee.
- 6. Affiliated societies would be invited to the zonal meetings for academic participation. 5 such zonal meetings have been proposed every year in UP. Lifetime affiliation fees for a society is Rs, 5000/-. Forms for affiliation are available at the Secretariat.
