- Scientific abstract must have at least one society member as an author or co-author.
- Articles published or submitted for publication in peer reviewed journals will not be accepted.
- Last date submission 31st August 2024
- The judge's decision will be final.

CATEGORIES UNDER WHICH PRESENTATIONS ARE TO BE SENT

Dr. Mohan Lal Gold Medal symposium:

Awarded for the best paper presented in this session. Upper age limit for participation in 35 years. Preference will be given to the work done by one person.

Dr. P. Awasthi Medal

Awarded preferably to single author work by an Ophthalmologist 40 years of age or more. Five copies of complete paper should be submitted to the chairman scientific committee two months before the conference. Best paper will be selected by a panel of judges on the basis of originality, comprehension and conclusiveness of the work.

Dr. V. N. Raizada Memorial Award Medal

Awarded on the basis of quality of work and presentation based on simple and innovative ideas, No age bar.

Dr. P. K. Pandey

Award for best paper presented on original work related to community ophthalmology on the basis of quality of work and presentation.

Dr. Awadh Dubey Award

Awarded to best paper by selection related to surgical ophthalmology specialty meant for rural population.

Prof. Jitendra Agrawal Award

Awarded to best paper by selection in the field of oculoplasty or pediatric ophthalmology. The Award will consist of a citation or certificate and a cash award of Rs.10000/- (Rupees Ten thousand).

Prof. V. Thakur Award

Awarded to best paper in the field of cornea and Eye Banking by selection.

Free Paper

Best paper of each session will be awarded a certificate of merit

Papers are selected for the presentation on the basis of quality of work.

This year the best paper among all sessions would be given **Dr. Sandeep Mittal Award**.

ABSTRACT

Should not exceed more than 500 words Title should not exceed more than 100 characters. The text should include aim of study, material and methods, results and conclusion. It should not show your identity or place in title.

Is the title descriptive of abstract?

Does the abstract contain a concise statement?

- Objective
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusion

Abstracts with statements such as no data, or insufficient data, wrong methodology, not enough subject to draw the conclusion will not be accepted.

PAPERS (Max 6 Min) Time clock will buzz and audio video will stop automatically Duration of presentation is 6 minutes only. Signed hard copy with soft copy of the paper will have to be handed over to hall in charge before presentations without which presentation will be disallowed.

POSTER

Size-4*3 feet. Poster should include introduction, material and methods, results, discussion (if any) and conclusion.

E-Poster

Should be submitted in 8 ppt only on email or upload in poster area in Conference Hall.
